Mission Team Preparation of the Heart

As you make your preparations, the staff at Naomi requests that you spend some time before your trip preparing yourself spiritually, both individually and as a team. We have found that if you are grounded in the truth, life's big surprises, both good and bad, will not catch you off-guard.

Ask God what He wants to show you during this mission trip. Much of what you get out of your experience is determined by how much you put into it.

To help mentally equip you for the trip, here are some helpful perspectives and lists for your consideration.

“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men” – Colossians 2:23

As you prepare, please consider the following:

- Lift up Jesus Christ with your thoughts, words, and actions
- Develop and maintain a servant's attitude
- Pray for and support your team leaders and their decisions
- No alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, offensive clothing and profanity
- Be positive and encouraging
- Remember what you learned as a child, “If you can't say anything nice, don't say anything at all.”
- Be a team player, not a gossip
- Remember the missionary job is to learn and serve, not to lecture and direct
- Be open to different perspectives and ways of doing things
- Remember you are a guest in a different culture. Enjoy it and learn.
